The following areas will require proof of vaccination to enter, as per government guidelines, effective October 22nd, 2021:

Restaurant, bar, fitness center, and meeting facilities.

We have taken the following actions to continue our drive to be the cleanest and safest hotel in our Province:

Public Spaces

We have doubled down on our cleaning protocols. Public spaces and high-traffic areas are wiped down constantly each day with disinfectant.

Hand Sanitizer and Face Masks

Face masks are mandatory in all public spaces including lobby, hallways, restaurant, meeting rooms, etc. Hand sanitizing stations have been installed throughout the building. Face Masks are available at our front desk for guests.

Physical Distancing

Plexiglas shields have been installed in our front desk and dining room areas. Physical distancing markers have been placed on the floor around the front desk and dining room counters. Contactless check-out available.

Guest Rooms

Cleaning protocols have been enhanced. Clean Stay Room Labels are applied to indicate that guest rooms haven't been accessed since they were cleaned. All non-essential amenities have been removed from your room but items can be ordered and delivered outside your door.
